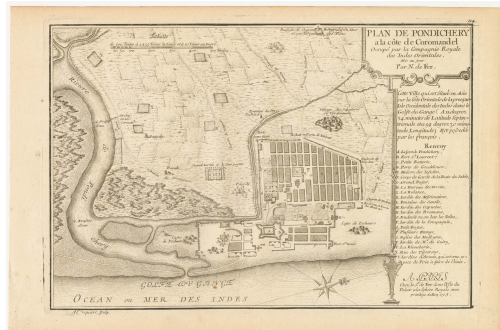




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A PLAN OF PUDUCHERRY AT THE BEGINNING OF THE 18TH CENTURY

An early plan of the main French colony in India, founded when the French East India Company set up a trading centre there in 1674. Although it was captured several times by Dutch and the British, Pondicherry (or Puducherry) remained in French hands until 1954.
