Product Description

A map showing the world in a single hemisphere, depicting those parts of the world that Catholic missionaries had reached. California is shown as an Island. Nova Hollandia (Australia) is now clearly separated from Nova Guinea, although without a Southern Coastline. Northwest and Northeast passages are shown. It is decorated with vignettes of a ship crossing the ocean, Christ with a cross and herdsmen separating the sheep from the goats (an allegory of Christian missionaries), with the goats entering the mouth of a monster.
