A detailed British army map of Singapore on a scale of 1 inch to a mile, published during the Japanese occupation of World War II. It was prepared by the Royal Engineers with updates taken from aerial photography. The layouts of the airfields used by the Japanese, including Seletar, Tengah & Kallang, are shown. The map was published less than four months before the surrender of the local Japanese forces (12th September 1945).

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
